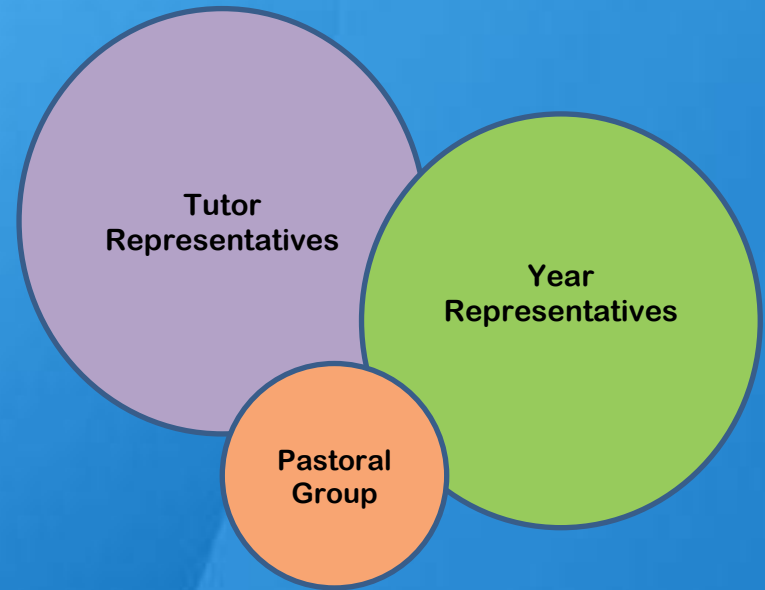

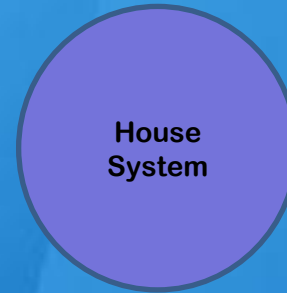

They are called:

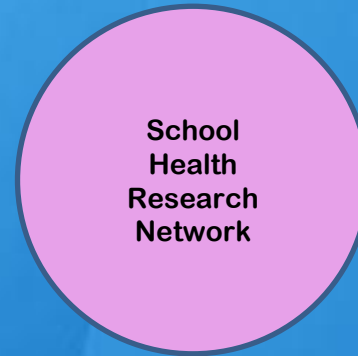
Deheubarth (Blue)

and Vice Captain from Year 11- GSC



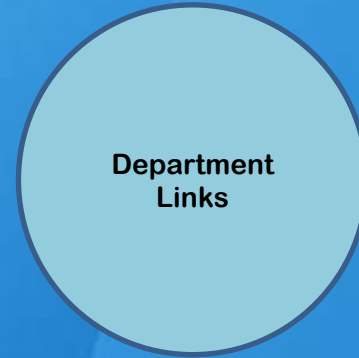
