

# Geography Exam Revision

At Ysgol y Grango pupils study WJEC GCSE Geography. Geography is a popular option at GCSE and groups are currently taught by Miss A Price, the Subject Leader. Content is organised around key questions and learners are encouraged to pose geographical questions of their own.

The content for GCSE Geography is split into three sections:

## **Unit 1: Changing Physical and Human Landscapes**

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes. 40% of qualification - 83 marks.

- Section A Core Themes:
  - Theme 1: Landscapes and Physical processes.
  - Theme 2: Rural-urban Links.

## **Unit 2: Environmental and Development Issues**

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes. 40% of qualification - 83 marks.

- Section A Core Themes:
  - Theme 5: Weather, Climate and ecosystems.
  - Theme 6: Development and Resource Issues.
- Section B:
  - Theme 7: Social Development Issues

## **Unit 3: Fieldwork Enquiry**

- Two days of fieldwork spent developing fieldwork skills and collecting data
- Non-examination assessment: 2 hours and 30 minutes; 20% of qualification, taken in Year 11
